Thank you to our partners at ISLD for their continued support.</p> <p>Shout out to Heather coordinating resources for Spring Rx takeback. Spring has a much larger turnout. Will be hosted at Blue Cross of Idaho. Idaho Crime Prevention Association: option for shred event. Not pursuing due to no funding. Discussion with Public Works and the City to coordinate a shred. What happens next spring when PFS resources are no longer available? Seeking mini grant opportunities to fill the need. Federal grants can sometimes be more work than benefit due to strict parameters and heavy administrative oversight. CDC has reduced some of it's reporting requirements for grants which might make it more feasible to apply.</p> <p>Each year city council members are assigned as liaisons for different departments. New liaison is Councilwoman Strader who will join a few meetings. Newly appointed Councilman Overton is filling Treg Bernt's position.</p> <p>One of the evidence-based programs (EBP) we are looking at: CATCH. Vaping Preventions. Talks about life skills as well. Reaching out and having conversations with others in the state to see how implementation has gone. Even though we have collaborated with West Ada in the past, there are some parameters that can make it hard to help provide prevention education. Will be reaching out to other partners such as Boys and Girls Club to have conversations about providing EBPs.</p> <p>Boys and Girls Club Family Dinner Night / Connecting together event: Does anyone want to volunteer with Hailey and Kendall Thursday the 26th at these events? David Phillips will assist at Boys and Girls Club and earl Scharff will volunteer at the Kune event. ACSO and Kuna School District have events coming up: Rocky Herron is key note speaker. Connecting Together Event Thursday, January 26 is free and open to the public. It will be held at the Performing Arts Center at Kuna High School. Boise Blast Event is private: Discussion on Fentanyl.
